

## How to use this website

Please note that this website does not claim to be comprehensive – the site as it has been put up in late 2004 is the first phase of what it is hoped will be further developed, particularly by having documentation in Kiswahili, more pictures, and eventually some video material.

One of the aims of the site has been to bring together links to other useful sites. If you know of other links, please contact me by using the form on the contacts page.

Here are a few helpful hints on using the site:

### a) links

- If a link does not work, try again later.
- If it still does not work, take off the last part of the URL and try the home page of that particular site – some sites have a search facility which may enable you to locate what you want
- If you are still having problems, use a search engine like Google ([www.google.com](http://www.google.com)) to put in key words, including the names of authors if there is one.

### b) maps

- You can usually enlarge a map by clicking on the bottom right-hand corner

### c) photos

- If you right-click on the photos on each page, holding down the mouse button slightly, a caption explaining the photos will come up.
- These small photos ('thumb-nails') cannot be expanded, but the pictures in the Photo Gallery page can be.
